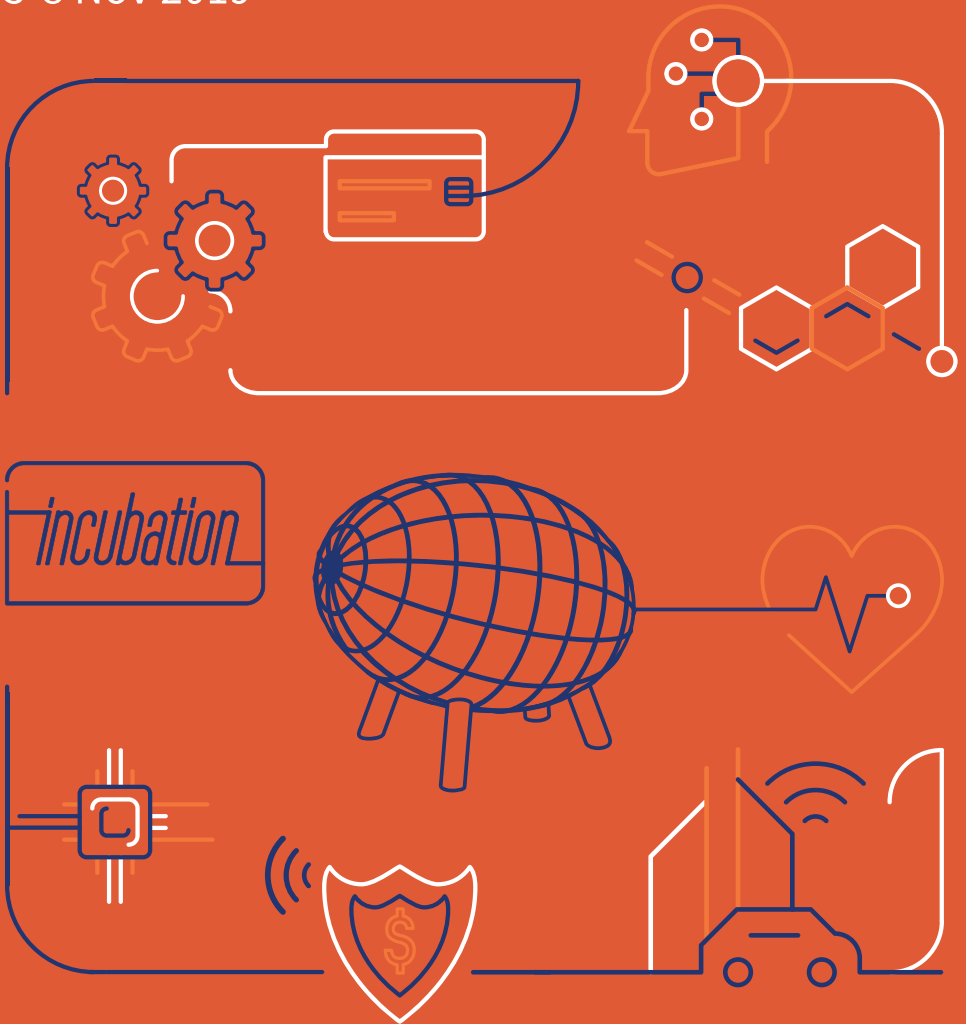

About AABI

Established in 2002, Asian Association of Business Incubation (AABI) is an international nonprofit organization that focuses on building incubation industry ecosystem in Asia-pacific region.

Our mission is to promote business incubation activities among business incubators, client companies and other related organizations in Asia-pacific region, to encourage core incubation business between different Asian incubators, to support ambitious Asian Tech-SMEs innovate and go internationally.

In all, AABI is aimed to promote overall economic development in Asian economies. Considering the diversity of Asia-pacific countries, this mission is in no way easy. BUT, we are committed to it!

Who are AABI Members?

About AABI Members

Originally constituted by 9 founding members from 8 countries and regions (including Korea, Singapore, China, India, Malaysia, Japan, Chinese Taipei and Hong Kong), AABI now develops into a large community which includes 23 Association Members and 36 Incubator Members from 19 countries and regions.

Apart from the wide coverage, AABI members are also diverse in their institutional roles. Our member portfolio now comprises maker's space, business incubators, accelerator, Science Park, as well as coordinating association and policymaker in incubation system, etc.

Hong Kong Science & Technology Parks Corporation (HKSTP)



Comprising Science Park, InnoCentre and Industrial Estates located in Tai Po, Tseung Kwan O and Yuen Long, Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation (HKSTP) is a statutory body dedicated to fostering innovation and technology advancement in Hong Kong through the provision of state-of-the-art facilities and high caliber end-to-end services. Since its establishment in 2001, HKSTP has been entrusted with strengthening Hong Kong's position as a regional technology hub by promoting innovation, technology development and commercialisation of five technology clusters: Biotechnology, Electronics, Green Technology, Information Technology and Telecommunications, and Precision Engineering. HKSTPC also offers full service Incubation Programmes, with incubation period from 12-48 months for technology start-ups to accelerate their growth.

As of today, HKSTP has attracted more than 700 technology companies, which employ a workforce of close to 13' 000 in Science Park. In 2016, the corporation received 3 recognitions of its incubation work, that includes "InBIA's Technology/IT Incubator of the Year", "Dinah Adkins Incubator of the Year", and "InBIA Randall M. Whaley Award - Incubator of the Year Award". In 2017, HKSTP became the first Hong Kong organization to be named a "National-level Technological Companies Incubator" by the Ministry of Science and Technology of the People's Republic of China. In 2018, the first ever A.I. technology development platform in Hong Kong, the Hong Kong AI & Data Laboratory Limited, was established jointly by Alibaba Group (NYSE: BABA), SenseTime and HKSTPC, which focused on advancing the frontiers of A.I. with cutting-edge technologies and expertise, and empowering startups to commercialize their new inventions. Finally yet importantly, it won the "AABI Incubator of the Year" award in 2019. These high-level recognitions underscores HKSTP's efforts and contributions in incubating start-ups, developing talent and providing funding support to our partner companies.

Elevator Pitch Competition, "EpiC" in short, is a fun-filled international start-up event organised by Hong Kong Science and Technology Parks Corporation (HKSTPC). 100 start-ups will be selected to pitch their ideas in a 60-second elevator ride at the International Commerce Centre (ICC), the most iconic skyscraper in Hong Kong. They will compete for the chance to win an investment prize of not less than US\$120,000!

There were one hundred high potential start-ups from 24 economies took part in the Elevator Pitch Competition 2018 (EpiC) last year. The global signature start-up event drew a record high number of 591 applications, including both local and international start-ups. The competition attracted more than 1,000 entrepreneurs, venture capital firms, angel investors, industry players, incubators, accelerators and tech disruptors together.

Networking	You can mingle with an amazing lineup of entrepreneurs, industrialists, incubators, accelerators and investors.

Transportation

Visitors can also drive to HKSTP via Tolo Highway. Travel time from the Park to Tsim Sha Tsui East is about 30 minutes. Travel time from HKSTP to Shenzhen, China is about 30 minutes.
